

Local Rules

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)**
Beyond any boundary, fence, hedge or wall or line of white stakes or lines.
- Beyond the white stakes at the 1st, 13th, 14th, 16th, 17th and 18th holes.
- Beyond the white stakes to the left of the 6th and 10th holes, only when playing these holes.
- Beyond the fence at the 2nd, 4th, 8th, 13th, and 18th holes.
- Over the wall at the 7th, 11th, 12th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 18th holes.
Note: The 12th medal tee is in bounds when playing the 12th hole.
- On or beyond the pathway or white stakes at the Club House.
- 2. PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN**
The practice putting green is a "wring green". A ball touching it must be lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 13.1f.

- 3. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**
All walls within the boundaries of the course.
The above areas are integral parts of the course. A ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable. Rule 19 applies.

- 4. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS (including moveable instructions)**
4.1. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16)
Areas marked as Ground Under Repair, by blue stakes or enclosed by white lines. If a player's ball lies in such an area or it interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing the player may take relief in accordance with Rule 16.1a.

- 4.2. YOUNG TREES (Rule 16)**
Staked trees identified by stakes are no play zones: if a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped within one club-length not nearer the hole. Rule 16.1f applies.

- 5. PENALTY AREA (Rule 17)**
Parts of the burn marked with yellow stakes or lines and all unmarked burns are penalty areas. (Rules 17.1d(1) and (2)) applies.
Any temporary Local Rules defined on the Starter's or Club Noticeboard.
